Established in 1992, ACE – The Association of Community Employment Programs for the Homeless – is a non-profit that provides vocational rehabilitation and workforce development services for men and women from throughout New York City, helping them find full time employment and achieve economic independence.

Our program participants are a visible presence throughout the city, working hard to keep public spaces and communities clean while learning the rules and responsibilities of the workplace.

OUR PROGRAM AND SERVICES

ACE provides participants with adult education, sector specific training, computer training, work experience opportunities, job placement assistance and wraparound services - including individualized counseling, financial coaching, and a lifelong aftercare program.

During their time at ACE, participants gain the skills, knowledge, and tools they need to become successful and empowered members of New York City's workforce. Program alumni have life-long access to ACE's services and receive continued support as they pursue personal and professional advancement.

ADMISSION CRITERIA & REQUIREMENTS

- Free Admissions and Referrals
- Housing: Applicants must have a stable living situation.
- Criminal History: Applicants with violent criminal histories will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- **Sobriety:** Applicants must have 30 days of sobriety from illegal substances.
- Availability: Applicants must be unemployed and able to commit to a 35 hour per week schedule.
- Work Authorization: Applicants must be at least 18 years old and be authorized to work legally in the United States.
